



## **SCOTLAND'S DX ASSOCIATION**

The GMDX Group is Scotland's first and largest group of HF and contest-orientated radio amateurs. It caters for all amateurs with an interest in competitive activity on the HF bands. Those interested in DX chasing, contesting and award chasing are specially catered for. Although the GMDX Group is based in Scotland, membership is open to all radio amateurs.

The GMDX Group's aims are:

- To hold an annual convention, where a number of DX-orientated subjects are covered, followed by a dinner
- To have at least two meetings per year with a DX-related presentation
- To support, where possible, major DXpeditions
- To encourage members' active participation in the DXCC programme
- To liaise with other DX clubs
- To produce a quarterly newsletter containing members' news and DX information

GMDX Group members include most of Scotland's top DXers, along with all of Scotland's Honour Roll members. Several members have taken part in DXpeditions to rare countries and the group is a checkpoint for the CQ magazine awards and the DXCC programmes.

The GMDX Group has an awards programme which sponsors the Islands of Scotland Award, Worked All Scottish Prefixes and Celtic Knot Award.

Since the founding of the Group in 1993, there have been many presentations by World-renowned DXpeditioners including Roger Western G3SXW, Nigel Cawthorne G3TXF, Peter Casier ON6TT, Ghis Penny ON5NT, Glenn Johnson W0GJ, Wayne Mills N7NG, Jim Smith VK9NS, as well as many others. We have also supported every major DXpedition since 1993 including D68C, 3B9C, VK0IR, 3Y0PI, 3Y0X, K7C, TI9M, VP8SDX and FR/F6KDF/T.

Membership is open to all radio amateurs with an interest in DX chasing, contesting and award hunting.

Current membership is £10 for UK members and £14 or US\$20 for the rest of the World.
